Admission requirements

- International students aged 18 or above at the time of program commencement.
- High-level of English language and comprehension skills are required to complete the course, IELTS 5.5 or equivalent is recommended.
- Students will be allocated to coursework or research depending on their academic level, as detailed in the 2025 program guide.
- Students must be enrolled in a medical or health sciences course in their home country.

- This program is only offered to UWA partner universities.

 Otherwise, the cost for a chaperone is AUD 3,290 (Option 2) or AUD 4,170 (Option 3).
- Selecting multiple options within a group may incur additional fees.
- All students are required to bring their own laptops.
- All participants are required to have their own comprehensive travel insurance to cover the entire program period, before departing from their home countries.
- NO booking has been made at this point. Bookings are not confirmed until a deposit has been received and acknowledged in writing by Uni Link.
- Any modifications made to the itinerary and group size may result in variations to the fees quoted.



Terms & Conditions (Group)

General

- At least one responsible adult (chaperone) must accompany the group.
- Participants have made this application having had access to sufficient information regarding the details of the program including, but not limited to, course requirements, fees, facilities and services.
- Classes may be combined with other groups or participants, depending on the UWA School's decision regarding class arrangements. If alternative arrangements are requested, additional fees may apply.
- All activities will be delivered, however Uni Link reserves the right to change the order in which activities are delivered to suit the timetable and availability. It may be necessary to substitute activities should the weather be inclement. This will be discussed with the chaperone(s) if needed.
- Any request to change arrangements after confirmation is subject to approval and may result in extra
 fees.
- Joining after the program has commenced is not allowed.
- There are no refunds if the participant decides not to join any class or activity during the program.
- UWA professional development transcript and certificate will only be issued to participants who successfully passed the course.
- Photos or/and videos taken during the program will be used for marketing purposes.

Information and Privacy

- All information provided to Uni Link should be complete and current. Participants understand that incomplete information and documentation may result in an unsuccessful application.
- False or misleading information and documentation may result in cancellation of participation in the program without a refund.
- Participants authorise Uni Link to book and arrange the program on their behalf including the disclosure
 of the information to any person or organisation, for the purposes of successful development and delivery
 of this program.

Group Size

A minimum number of participants is required to run the program. If the number of participants is less than the proposed number, please advise as soon as possible and request another proposal.

Off-campus Accommodation (hotel or short-term accommodation)

- Participants agree to adhere to the accommodation provider's rules and guidelines; failure to do so may result in a fine by the service provider.
- Shared bathrooms are common in accommodations in Australia. Personal hygiene items including but not limited to toothbrushes, body wash, slippers, hair dryers, etc., may not be provided.
- Same-sex arrangements will apply to shared room accommodation. Additional charges may apply in case of single occupancy in a shared room arrangement.

- Rooming modifications are not permitted after rooming arrangements have been confirmed.

Homestay Accommodation

- Participants agree to adhere to the accommodation provider's rules and guidelines; failure to do so may result in a fine by the service provider.
- Participants must be 16 years or older to stay in homestay accommodation.
- Shared bathrooms are common in accommodations in Australia. Personal hygiene items including but not limited to toothbrushes, body wash, slippers, hair dryers, etc., may not be provided.
- · Same-sex arrangements will apply to shared room accommodation.
- Rooming modifications are not permitted after rooming arrangements have been confirmed.
- Participants with special dietary requirements may be charged an additional fee to cover additional fees to homestay hosts (i.e. halal, gluten-free, vegan, kosher, vegetarian).
- · Special requests cannot be guaranteed; however, Uni Link will try to accommodate them.
- Standard Check-In/Check-Out hours: 10:00 to 21:00. Check-out after 12:00 will be charged an extra night fee and is subject to availability.

Homestay: Group Airport Transfer Policies

Arrival: participants will be picked up from Perth Airport (PER) and transported to the UWA meeting point. Homestay families will be responsible for picking up students at the UWA meeting point.

Departure: participants will be dropped off by their homestay families at the UWA meeting point and then transported from the UWA meeting point to Perth Airport.

The drop-off service is designed with the intention of participants arriving at the airport 3 hours prior to their scheduled flight departure. Please note that the exact timing of the drop-off may vary based on factors such as group size, traffic conditions, or other external circumstances. While Uni Link will make every effort to provide a timely arrival, Uni Link cannot be held responsible for delays beyond our control.

On-campus Accommodation

- Participants agree to adhere to the accommodation provider's rules and guidelines; failure to do so may result in a fine by the service provider.
- Participants generally must be 18 years or older to stay in on-campus accommodation. However, subject to availability, participants under 18 may be considered for on-campus accommodation.
- Shared bathrooms are common in accommodations in Australia. Personal hygiene items including but not limited to toothbrushes, body wash, slippers, hair dryers, etc., may not be provided.
- Same-sex arrangements will apply to shared room accommodation. Additional charges may apply in case of single occupancy in a shared room arrangement.
- Room upgrades are subject to availability and additional fees or extra charges may be incurred.
- · Rooming modifications are not permitted after rooming arrangements have been confirmed.
- Standard accommodation check-in time is 14:00 and check-out time is 10:00. Early check-in or late check-out is subject to approval. Additional fee charges may be incurred for check-in/check-out times outside of the standard time.

On-campus: Flight and Arrival/Departure Information

This section is especially crucial for those who choose not to travel with the group, as it contains essential information to review before booking flights or for those who have already made their arrangements. Additionally, it includes relevant details for all students, such as luggage storage policy.

Flight booking

We highly recommend choosing a flight that arrives and departs during the day or as advised by your contact person to facilitate group travel. If this isn't possible, please keep the following in mind:

General Information

- Reception hours: on arrival and departure days, reception is open from 9:00 to 21:00.
- No 24/7 service: there is no 24/7 service at the accommodation. This will impact your check-in, check-out and luggage storage, so please be aware of this when booking flights.

Arrival

- Transportation: participants taking a different flight than advised and cannot use group transport, need to arrange their own transportation from Perth Airport to the accommodation.
- Check-in: available from 14:00 to 21:00.
- Luggage storage: available from 09:00 to 14:00.
 Note: participants will not have access to stored luggage until check-in time
- Dinner: participants arriving after the scheduled dinner time will not be provided dinner.

Departure

- Check-out: at 10:00. Please notify Uni Link if you need to check out earlier.
- Late check-out: needs to be requested and is subject to approval.
- Luggage storage: available from 10:00 until late (participants taking a different flight than advised and are unable to use group transport, need to arrange their own transportation to Perth Airport and can only store luggage until 17:00 or as late as the group)
 - Note: participants will not have access to stored luggage until the pickup time.
- Breakfast: participants departing before the scheduled breakfast time will not be provided breakfast. Weekend breakfast times are typically later than those on weekdays and will be subject to the provider.

Meals

- Dining times are subject to the provider, usual dining times are Breakfast: 07:00 – 09:00 / Lunch: 12:00 – 14:00 / Dinner: 18:00 – 20:00
- Meal offerings are at the discretion of the provider. For breakfast, continental breakfast is the standard provision to serve.

Loss & Insurance

- All participants must arrange their own comprehensive travel insurance for the entire duration of the program before departing from their home country.
- Participants are responsible for any expenses, losses, injuries, damages, inconvenience, etc., sustained by themselves in the program.

Booking and Payment

- No booking has been made at this point.
- Booking is subject to payment of a minimum 50% deposit of the program fees per participant upon application and it is non-refundable. The balance must be received at least 8 weeks prior to the start of the program.
- Group payment is preferred.
- Uni Link will not cover bank charges or any surcharges.
- All fees listed are inclusive of a 10% Goods and Services Tax (GST).

Force Majeure

In the event of outside reasonable control and/or not being in a position to prevent the event which affects the delivery of the program, no refund will be made and no responsibility will be taken by Uni Link. Refunds or compensation will be subject to participants' own comprehensive travel insurance.

Below are some examples of the event (including but not limited to):

- · Weather and natural disasters;
- · War, riot, or act of terrorism;

- · A government direction or sanctioned lockdown;
- · Widespread illness including but not limited to an epidemic or pandemic.

Substitutions

One substitution is permitted per group, and only up to 8 weeks prior to the program start date. Additional charges may apply due to the gender split and rooming arrangements.

Cancellations

- Cancellation must be informed in writing through completion of a Withdrawal and Refund Form and is not effective until received by Uni Link.
- Uni Link will not cover bank charges or other surcharges.
- In case of cancellation, refunds will be based on the following table:
