- Improvement in medical communication skills in English



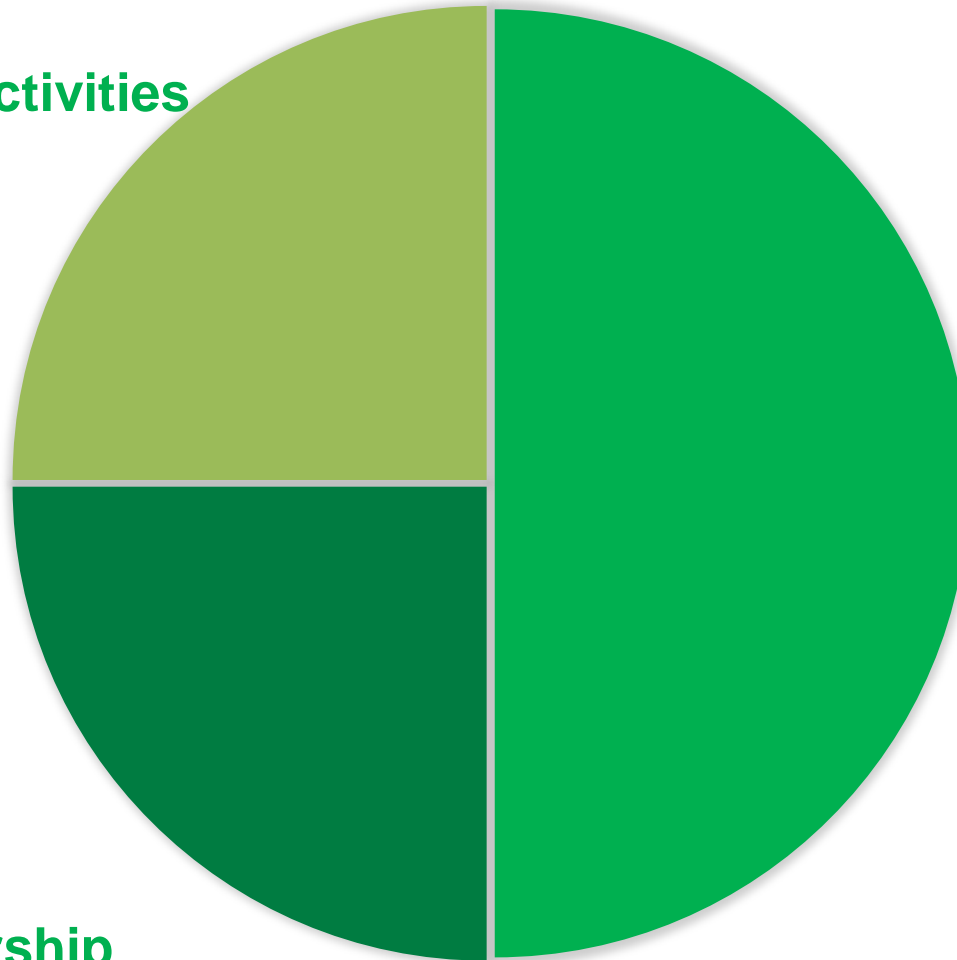
Candidates:
