CDS Biomedical Education Program

Syllabus

Sunday, August 4- Friday, August 30, 2019 (4 weeks)

MMP 194 Course (8 units) Components:

Professional English – 36 hours lecture time

This course focuses on the language of medicine in English, both spoken and written. It is designed to help students to master specific medical vocabulary and idioms and to improve their ability to communicate in English in a hospital or clinical setting. This course also incorporate English practice in which students have the opportunity to communicate in English.

(Students will take two of the following three courses)

Medical Pharmacology - 24 hours lecture time

This course is intended to instruct students in the basic mechanisms by which drugs interact with human cells and tissues. This course will provide students with a basic foundation in the principles of pharmacology and therapeutics, which will equip the student to eventually make rational and correct therapeutic decisions.

Tumor Biology - 24 hours lecture time

This course is designed to provide students with a current and comprehensive review of biologic structure and function at the cellular, tissue, and organ system levels. Clinical correlation sessions, which illustrate the contributions of cell biology to specific medical problems, are interspersed in the lecture schedule.

Medical Virology – 24 hours lecture time

The course will emphasize the common reactions that must be completed by all viruses for successful reproduction within a host cell and survival and spread within a host population. The implications of viral infection in clinic will also be discussed.
